A community-driven solution to enhance health systems, reduce economic burden, and provide timely, life-saving intervention for children suffering from **Congenital Heart Disease (CHD)** in Vietnam.



A Proven Partnership for Sustainable Impact

This initiative is built on a strong foundation of international cooperation and local expertise, ensuring every aspect of the project is managed effectively and responsibly.

Our Two-Pronged Strategy: Immediate Treatment & Proactive Prevention

Our project addresses the CHD crisis from two critical angles: providing immediate relief to children in urgent need while investing in a long-term system for early detection.



Scope 1 - Life-Saving Surgeries

Financially support 40 life-saving heart surgeries for children from families in difficult circumstances.

Immediate Intervention



Scope 2 - Rural Heart Screening

Fund a rural outreach trip to screen 1,500 children, enabling early detection before defects become severe.

Long-Term Prevention

Scope 1: Delivering 40 Life-Saving Surgeries

To cover the full surgical expenses for 40 children with CHD who are certified as living in difficult circumstances.



Our funding bridges the critical gap, ensuring beneficiary families are not required to pay any portion of the surgery costs. This removes the primary barrier to treatment.

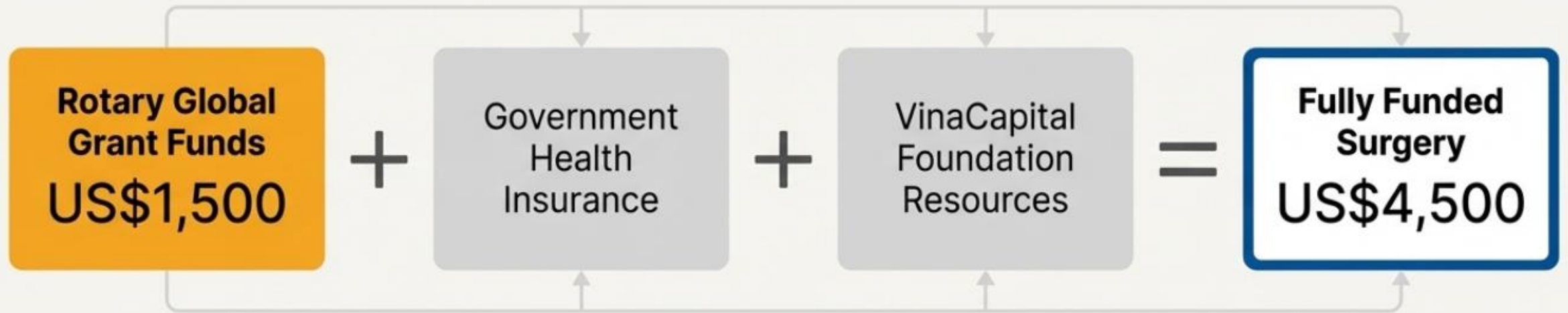

The Power of Leverage: How Rotary's Investment is Multiplied

Rotary's contribution is the catalyst that unlocks a comprehensive funding package, making a US\$4,500 surgery possible and completely free for the family.



Rotary's US\$1,500 commitment per child is essential.

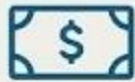
It activates matching funds from government insurance programs.

VCF contributes its own resources and negotiates costs to cover all remaining expenses.

Every dollar from Rotary unlocks approximately two additional dollars in value, ensuring maximum impact for our investment.

Scope 2: Expanding Early Detection in Remote Communities

Objective: To fund one provincial outreach trip using the VinaCapital Foundation's proven Rural Outreach Clinics (ROC) program to find children with previously undiagnosed heart defects.



US\$4,000: The total investment for the entire outreach mission.

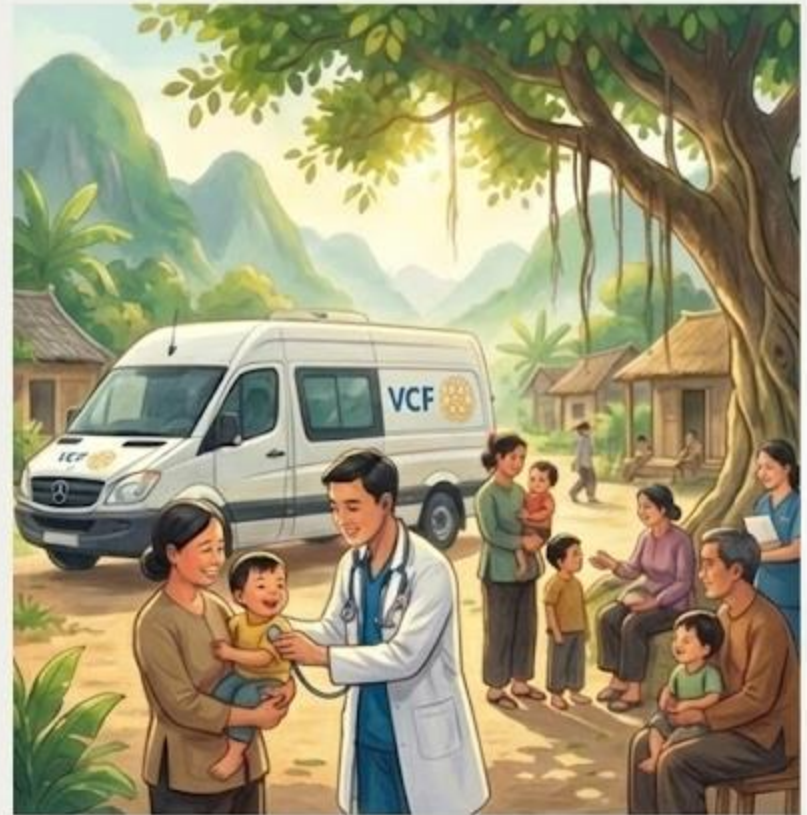


1,500: Approximate number of children to be screened.



2-4: locations visited per clinic

Early detection is vital. Heart defects detected late are more severe, more complex to treat, and often fatal. This proactive screening saves lives and reduces future healthcare costs.



A Transparent and Efficient Project Budget

The total project budget is designed for maximum efficiency, with the vast majority of funds going directly to program services.

Life-Saving Surgeries (Scope 1) (US\$1,500 per case x 40 cases)	US\$60,000
Rural Heart Screening Outreach (Scope 2) (Funding for 1 provincial trip)	US\$4,000
Administrative Project Expenses (Covering essential project coordination)	US\$500

Total Grant Request: US\$64,500

Funding the Mission: Our Collaborative Contribution

We are seeking a Global Grant of US\$64,500 to be funded through the collaborative partnership of our sponsoring club, district, and The Rotary Foundation.

World Fund matches 80%
of DDF ($\$28k \times 0.80$)

The Rotary Foundation's "World Fund" provides a match, but only on the DDF amount, not the cash.

District provides a 2:1 match
on club cash ($\$14k \times 2$)

The District matches the club's cash. In this specific example, they are applying a 2-to-1 match ratio ($2 \times \$14,000 = \$28,000$). Note: this match can be 1 or 2 times the club cash depending on district's guidelines. Check with YOUR DISTRICT GRANTS CHAIRPERSON*
